Horses: All horses must be marked with their number at any time

Health requirements: Every athlete is obliged to deliver all necessary health certificates for the transport to the event or identification of the horses before they come into the stables.
a) In case of arrival from a EU-member-country, a valid health certificate is necessary.
b) In case of arrival from a country not belonging to the E.U. a health certificate for registered horses will be necessary, the Athlete must carry with him the original certificate, not a copy. The organizer sees to it that on the competition site, an official state veterinarian is present to issue the health certificates with are necessary for the transport of the horses to their destination abroad.
Furthermore, questions relating to health requirements for horses can be directed to the veterinarian authorities in the country of origin of in Germany.

National requirements: In addition to the rules and regulations applicable as set out above the following national regulations apply:

-German Law concerning Manufacture and distribution of medicines (Arzneimittelgesetz)
-German Animal Health Act (Tiergesundheitsgesetz)
-German Regulation for Animal-Welfare during Transport (Tierschutztransportverordnung)
-German Regulation regarding livestock Transport (Viehverkehrsverordnung)

Vaccinations: Horses competing at this event must comply with the requirements for Equine Influenza vaccination in accordance with the veterinary regulations.

Minor Riders: All minor riders must wear a helmet
